It's amazing how different falafel sandwiches can be from one another. Myrna's was a wrap, the sandwich encased in a thin pita, falafels snuggled inside with lettuce, tomato, tahini sauce and turnip pickles. It must have been the pickles that gave this wrap such unique flavor. I kept wondering what that slightly smoky vegetable taste was. It was good, but unlike anything I've tasted before, which I always enjoy. The falafels were tasty, if a bit soft, but Myrna's gets extra points for having a cool Northern California atmosphere—a great place for a first date since it's very casual; they serve wine too.
